Winning entries will be published in full color in the January 2007 issue of ELEVATOR WORLD, and the first-place submitter in each category will be acknowledged with an award of recognition bearing the official **ELEVATOR WORLD Project of the Year** seal.

CONTEST RULES AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. Contest entry period begins June 1, 2006 and ends August 30, 2006.
2. The transportation-system portion of the project must have been completed within two years of the contest entry period. Incomplete projects and previously submitted Project of the Year entries are not eligible.
3. Entries must include the required entry materials listed below.
4. All submissions will become property of ELEVATOR WORLD, and must be accompanied by the project owner's permission for ELEVATOR WORLD to run the submission as a feature story in ELEVATOR WORLD.
5. ELEVATOR WORLD reserves the right to accept or reject any submissions for not complying with the contest rules or not meeting the spirit of the ELEVATOR WORLD Project of the Year contest.
6. All employees of ELEVATOR WORLD and their families are ineligible to participate.

For each entry, fill out this form (or a copy) and attach it to the front cover of your entry. Enclose the following materials, each item to its own page (or pages):

- ◆ a one-page description of the entire project;
- ◆ a one- to five-page description of the transport system, providing the project details, transport-system outline specifications and why the project should be considered for an award;
- ◆ a list of credits, citing building owner, developer, architect, designer, planner, transport-systems contractor, equipment manufacturer(s), component supplier(s), consultant(s) and other pertinent project participants (companies only). Be sure to include the contact person's name, company name, address and phone number; and
- ◆ at least six color photographs which capture the major aspects of the project, with particular emphasis on the transport system and brief descriptions of each aspect. If digital images are used, high-resolution image files should be included on a CD with the project entry.
